Batik Drawing

You will need:
Paper
Oil Pastels
Black Acrylic Paint

Batik is an ancient art of creating pattern on fabric or paper. It is very popular in Indonesia.

You are going to create your own batik abstract drawing.



Begin by drawing a design on a white piece of paper using oil pastels. Make sure you use your muscles to press hard, so your paper is very well covered. When you have finished covering the entire page, scrunch your paper up. I know this sounds strange, but you need the creases in your paper to create the effect.



Flatten out your paper and using watered down black paint, paint over your image.



Once it is dry you can use black oil pastel to outline the shapes or leave it as it is. You might like to glue is onto a black background as above.


In previous lessons you have performed and compared different types of throws. Discuss the following reflective questions before beginning:
